The European Quota Tournament for the Youth Olympic Games in Nanjing, China, in August 2014 was held on 22 May 2014 during the European Youth Championships in Ljubljana. In total, 44 boys and 30 girls were standing on the shooting line. Ukraine, Russia and Switzerland for boys, and Germany, Slovenia, and Finland for girls won the last qualification places for the Youth Olympic Games.

Sanction

Iranian archer Hamzeh NEKOEI has been sanctioned with two years of sport ineligibility following an anti-doping rule violation. He was tested positive for the masking agent glycerol on 1 November 2013, a prohibited specific substance listed under S5 (Diuretics and other masking agents), at the 2013 Asian Archery Championships in Chinese Taipei.
