Nimes 2018

Steve Wijler, Kris Schaff, Natalia Avdeeva and Kim Surin took gold medals at the third stage of the 2017/18 Indoor Archery World Cup in Nimes, France, jumping up the rankings and putting themselves in qualifying positions for the Final in Las Vegas.

The men's final came down to the last set. Wijler shot 10-10-10; Ellison 9*-10-10 – and the first arrow was ruled out. "It's getting to the point, now, that in recurve men you can't miss. It's a can't miss game and it's getting exciting," said Ellison.

The Indoor Archery World Cup continues in Las Vegas in two weeks, with the first two days of the Vegas Shoot acting as stage four of the circuit, and the Indoor Archery World Cup Final taking place in the evening of the second day of competition.

Gymnasiade 2018

The organising committee of the Gymnasiade will offer special assistance to 30 African Countries to attend the 2018 Championship of the International School Sport Federation (ISF) to be held in Marrakesh from 2 to 9 May, even if they are not members of the ISF.



Lodging, local transportation, catering and registration fees will be taken care of by the Moroccan Government. This invitation is for 10 people: seven athletes, two coaches and one chief of delegation. The application deadline is set for 20 April. Airfares are due to be paid by the delegations.

Following their General Assembly, the Sudanese Archery Federation took the unanimous decision to suspend Mr Mohamed Adam Gibreel (Mr Anwar) from his position as Secretary General and expel him for life from all functions within the federation. The Assembly, which was attended by all members, based their decision on the serious violations committed by Mr Gibreel, such as administrative offences which jeopardised the interests of archery in Sudan.
