FITA CONGRESS - MINUTES BEIJING, P.R. CHINA 13th – 14th September 2001

1. OPENING OF CONGRESS

Before the President opens the Congress, Mr. Raoul Theeuws, First Vice-President, on behalf of Council asks for a minute of silence in memoriam of the victims of the tragedy of the American continent.

The Council also proposes that during the competitions, the FITA flag remain half-mast. After a long reflection, even if other sports have decided to cancel or postpone their competitions, FITA feels that acts of terror must not affect all of our activity.

Mr. Mark Miller received a letter from the Congress expressing Congress' sympathy.

Mr. Jim Easton declares the Congress open.

The Secretary General, after the role call, announced that the number of member Associations with the right of vote were 68 (with a maximum of 76 the second day) and the vote boxes were distributed.

2. APOLOGISES FOR ABSENCE

Apologises for absence were received from Mr. Stanley Patterson, Mr. Douglas Thomson, Mr. Fred Gavin, Mr. Sebastien Flûte, Mr. Gian Piero Spada, Mr. Francesco Gnecci-Ruscione, Mr. Trujillo, Mr. Jimenez, Mr. Bob Smith, Mr. Gilbert Felli, Mr. Spyros Kapralos, Mr. Makis Asimakopoulos.

3. PRESIDENT'S OPENING REMARKS

The President welcomes all FITA delegates, and personally thanks Raoul Theeuws and the Congress for the kind words expressed. He asks to observe a minute of silence in memory of Mr. Schenk, honorary Vice-President, who passed away last year.

Mr. Easton reads the letter received from the IOC President, Mr. Jacques Rogge who wishes FITA a successful meeting and Championship and expresses his regret for not being present in Beijing.

The President thanks Mr. Terry Reilly for the good job done during the Olympic Games in Sydney, which were successful. Regarding the next Olympic Games, a report will be given during the Congress.

Two moderators will be helping the President during the Congress, as experienced in previous Council meetings.

Mr. Easton explains that the motion C&R 39 will be voted first as it represents a very important step for FITA's organization in the future.

4. ADDRESS BY GUESTS

Due to the special circumstances, some of the expected guests could not attend.

5. NOMINATION OF SCRUTINEERS

Mr. Neil Dimmock is elected as scrutineer.

6. VOTING PROCEDURE

A new voting system will be used this year for all votes. The IOC has already used this system. Several tests have been done before Congress to ensure the system is suitable for FITA needs

7. AFFILIATIONS

The following countries have been accepted as Member Association :

8. TO CONFIRM THE MINUTES

The minutes of the XLIII FITA Congress of Riom are taken as read and approved. .

9. MATTERS ARISING FROM THE MINUTES

- a. Regarding the Clout Archery, the rules will remain the same as the Ad-Hoc Clout Committee could not agree on a new set of rules. The Committee will continue to work and try to find a solution to solve the problem.

- b. TAC and C&R Committee did not implement the decision of Congress concerning Constitutions & Rules Motion 4, therefore the question is still open.
- c. Mr. Jamil Baharuddin is from Malaysia and not from INA as indicated on page 14 (27.1) of the Minutes.

10. PRESIDENT'S REPORTS

10.1 President's report.

A written report has been circulated prior to Congress. The President retraces FITA History and thanks Mrs. Lynne Evans and her ad-hoc committee for the good efforts on the organization of the 70th Anniversary of FITA. The final Celebration of the 70th Anniversary will take place on 14th September after the last day of Congress.

He thanks Justyna Chmielecka for the Ski-Archery Championships, which have been organized in difficult conditions.

The President also congratulates all people who took part to the "very difficult" preparation of the World Indoor Championships in Florence.

During its meeting of May, Council met with the Presidents of the Continental Associations and this was a success. This program will be continued, once a year.

The 2000 Olympic Games as well as the 2001 Akita World Games were very successful and the organizers are thanked.

In regards to the next Olympic Games, which will take place in Athens in 2004, the President mentions three important points: the size of the stadium, which can only accommodate 4 targets and therefore one additional day of competition is needed, the weather, which will be very hot during the day and the historic Venue, which offers FITA a unique and fantastic opportunity to offer a great show.

The President then reviewed the two key decisions of the IOC Session in Moscow:

- Election of Beijing as host city for the 2008 Games. FITA is very pleased with this choice and looks forward to competing there.
- Election of the new IOC President
Mr. Jacques Rogge, the new IOC President is a friend of Archery, and we look forward to work with him in the future.

Archery will be more and more present, in the program of multisport events, for example at Universiads and at the Gymnasiads in 2002 in France.

He concludes by thanking the FITA Council for the good job, the FITA Office based in Lausanne and all volunteers working for FITA.

The goals of FITA have been submitted by the President to Congress as required by the Constitution and were accepted.

10.2 Secretary General and Executive Director's report

Written reports have been distributed prior to Congress.

In addition to the office activities, the FITA Office has concentrated its efforts on Internet, on the development, on support of the Olympics and on TV.

12. ALLOCATION OF WORLD CHAMPIONSHIPS

Summary evaluation reports have been distributed before Congress. The full evaluation report is available at the FITA Office upon request of a Member Association.

12.1 World Junior Outdoor Target Championships in 2002 - CZE

This Championship will start on the 5th August 2002.

As mentioned in the evaluation report and mentioned by Mr. Jurak., attention needs to be given to the quality of food and accommodation. Another concern is the Visa access, and this point will be clarified by the Organizing Committee.

Council recommends to Congress to accept the bid. As voted, Congress accepted by 59 Yes / 5 No.

12.2 World Field Archery Championships in 2004 – CRO

The Championship will be held during the first week of July in the beautiful National Park of the Plitvice Lakes, which is recognized by UNESCO.

As mentioned in the evaluation report, the area is beautiful and it will be a chance for FITA to show to the world that Archery is an environmental sport. No problem with accommodation. If CRO organizes this Championships, it will receive financial help from the Government and the Olympic Committee.

Council recommends to Congress to accept the bid. As voted, Congress accepted by 64 Yes / 1 No.

12.3 World Indoor Target Championships in 2003 - FRA

As reported by Mr. Philippe Bouclet, it is the second time that Nimes is candidate city. Nimes is a big and tourist city easily reachable from Paris. They have the support of the entire area and from the government department.

The Championships will take place from 4th – 9th March 2003.

The program will be much shorter than in previous events as they will use two halls for the qualification rounds. The finals will take place in an historical location "the Arena" of Nimes. The accommodation price has still to be negotiated.

Council recommends to Congress to accept the bid. As voted, Congress accepted by 60 Yes / 0 No.

12.5 World Field Championships in 2006 - SWE

This Championship will take place on the West Coast of Sweden, in Göteborg. Many big events have already been organized in Sweden and especially in Gothenburg. The competition area will be at about 20min by bus from the hotels and the finals will take place in the center of the city.

The exact location for the qualification and elimination rounds will be decided at a later stage. The hotels are very good but the prices need further investigation. The budget has not been 100 percent finalized.

Council recommends to Congress to accept the bid. As voted, Congress accepted by 66 Yes / 0 No.

INTENTIONS

World Outdoor Target Championships in 2007

Mr. Gabelman, Sport Director of German Shooting Federation presented their project. GER would like to organize the Championships in 2007 and will apply officially at the Congress in 2003

They would like Archery to become an official school sport in Germany.

A World Championship is organized every year for different sports.

The Archery Championships will be organized in the area of Stuttgart, which is a key center of Economics. The International Airport is about 13km far from the center.

World Indoor Championships in 2005

MEX would like to organize the World Indoor Championships in Acapulco. The evaluation will be done during the coming months.

World Outdoor Championships in 2003

USA is looking for a city to organize this Championship. They will revert with more details as soon as possible.

POL has also sent a bid for 2003. The evaluation will be done and the decision will be taken during the next council meeting in Athens in December.

TUR is also interesting in submitting a bid.

World Junior Outdoor Target Championships in 2004

GNAS will submit a bid to host the 2004 Championships. This would be held in mid-July in Lilleshall National Sport Center.

Remark is made that the 2003 Outdoor Championships should be settled very soon as it will be the Olympic qualifying event.

Court of Arbitration of Sport

Here is an example of a judgement issued by the Swiss Federal Tribunal (Swiss Supreme Court) in a case opposing an athlete to an International Federation.

The athlete challenged a decision rendered by the Court of Arbitration for Sport, which had admitted its jurisdiction to settle a dispute (disciplinary matter). The athlete considered that he was not bound by the arbitration agreement referring to CAS, which was included in the rules of the International Federation.

The Swiss Federal Tribunal dismissed the appeal of the athlete and, more significantly, confirmed its practice in this field : the tribunal said that such arbitration clauses inserted in statutes of federations were valid even if they were not expressly accepted by all parties concerned or countersigned by them. According to this judgement, it is however necessary that the parties (the athlete in the present case) have actual knowledge of the arbitration clause and do not ignore their existence. Such information related to the existence of an arbitration clause in the IF rules can be published by the federation either in the athlete's licence, in the official bulletin of the federation or in entry forms on the occasion of sports events, for example.

Dear Colleagues and Friends, Sir, Madam

The IOC Executive Board has made various modifications to the Olympic Movement Anti-Doping Code (the "Code") in conformity with the provisions of Article 2, Chapter VII of the Code, namely, upon recommendation of the Foundation Board of the World Anti-Doping Agency ("WADA") after consultation of the parties concerned.

The modifications, which concern the replacement of the norm ISO Guide 25 by the norm ISO Guide 17025, are attached to this letter, as Annex 1, and shall come into effect not later than 18th January 2002.

For the sake of clarity, the documentation applicable to doping upon the occasion of the 2002 Salt Lake City Olympic Winter Games is:

the "**Olympic Movement Anti-Doping Code**", 1999 edition (previously distributed);

the "**Explanatory Memorandum Concerning the Application of the Olympic Movement Anti-Doping Code**", dated 1999 (previously distributed);

the "**amendment to Article 2 of Chapter I (General Provisions) of the Olympic Movement Anti-Doping Code**", dated 24th May 2000 (previously distributed, however, a copy is attached, for your easy reference, as Annex 2);

the list of "**Prohibited Classes of Substances and Prohibited Methods 2001-2002**" (previously distributed, however, a copy is attached, for your easy reference, as Annex 3); and the "**modifications to the Olympic Movement Anti-Doping Code regarding the replacement of the norm ISO Guide 25 by the norm ISO Guide 17025**" (referred to above and attached as Annex 1).

You should have all the above-noted documentation in your possession. If this is not the case, please let us know and we will immediately forward such documentation to you.

Please ensure that the documentation referred to above is forwarded to all persons linked to your organisation who have a need to know such documentation, in particular to the athletes, coaches and medical personnel.

ANNEX 1

Modifications to the Olympic Movement Anti-Doping Code as recommended by the WADA Foundation Board and agreed to by the IOC Executive Board - regarding the replacement of the norm ISO Guide 25 by the norm ISO Guide 17025

- a) *Appendix B, clause 6.6 be amended to read:* "From 1st January 2000 to maintain ISO Guide 17025 accreditation. "
- b) *Annex 3 to appendix B clause 5 be amended to read:*
"For any IOC accredited laboratory, failure to comply with the Rules of Ethics or to maintain ISO Guide 17025 Accreditation (from 1st January 2000) may lead to withdrawal of IOC Accreditation ".
- c) *Appendix D clause 1 be amended to read:*
"Laboratory analysis procedures are described below and should be in accordance with ISO Guide 17 025".
- d) Any reference to ISO Guide 25 in the Code or in related documents be changed to ISO Guide 17025.

Amendment to Article 2 of Chapter I General Provisions) of the Olympic Movement Anti-Doping Code

1.....This Code applies to all Participants.

2. All athletes are subject to doping controls (urine analyses, blood tests and other authorised techniques for detecting prohibited substances or methods).

SUBSTITUTES APPENDIX A OF THE OMAC 1999OLYMPIC MOVEMENT ANTI-DOPING CODE APPENDIX APROHIBITED CLASSES OF SUBSTANCES AND PROHIBITED METHODS 2001-20021 September 2001

I. PROHIBITED CLASSES OF SUBSTANCES

A. Stimulants

Prohibited substances in class (A) include the following examples:

amineptine, amiphenazole, amphetamines, bromantan, caffeine*, carphedon, cocaine, ephedrines^fencamfamin, formoterol^ mesocarb, pentetrazol, pipradrol, salbutamol***, salmeterol***, terbutaline**^ ... and related substances.**

For caffeine the definition of a positive is a concentration in urine greater than 12 micrograms per milliliter.

For cathine, the definition of a positive is a concentration in urine greater than 5 micrograms per milliliter. For ephedrine and methylephedrine, the definition of a positive is a concentration in urine greater than 10 micrograms per milliliter. For phenylpropanolamine and pseudoephedrine, the definition of a positive is a concentration in urine greater than 25 micrograms per milliliter.

Permitted by inhaler only to prevent and/or treat asthma and exercise-induced asthma.. Written notification by a respiratory or team physician that the athlete has asthma and/or exercise-induced asthma, is necessary to the relevant medical authority prior to competition.. At the Olympics Games, athletes who request permission to inhale a permitted beta agents will be assessed by an independent medical panel.

NOTE: All imidazole preparations are acceptable for topical use. Vasoconstrictors may be administered with local anaesthetic agents. Topical preparations (e.g. nasal, ophthalmological, rectal) of adrenaline and phenylephne are permitted.

B. Narcotics

Prohibited substances in class (B) include the following examples:

buprenorphine, dextromoramide, diamorphine (heroin), methadone, morphine, pentazocine, pethidine, ... and related substances.

NOTE: codeine, dextromethorphan, dextropropoxyphene, dihydrocodeine, diphenoxylate, ethylmorphine, pholcodine, propoxyphene and tramadol are permitted-

C. Anabolic agents

Prohibited substances in class (C) include the following examples:

1. Anabolic androgenic steroids

a. clostebol, fluoxymesterone, metandienone, metenolone, nandrolone, 19-norandrostenediol, 19-norandrostenedione, oxandrolone, stanozolol, ... and related substances.

b. androstenediol, androstenedione, dehydroepiandrosterone (DHEA), dihydrotestosterone, testosterone*, ... and related substances.

Evidence obtained from metabolic profiles and/or isotopic ratio measurements may be used to draw definitive conclusions-

* The presence of a testosterone (T) to epitestosterone (E) ratio greater than six (6) to one (1) in the urine of a competitor constitutes an offence unless there is evidence that this ratio is due to a physiological or pathological condition, e.g. low epitestosterone excretion, androgen producing tumour, enzyme deficiencies-In the case of T/E greater than 6, it is mandatory that the relevant medical authority conducts an investigation before the sample is declared positive. A full report will be written and will include a review of previous tests, subsequent tests and any results of endocrine investigations- In the event that previous tests are **not** available, the athlete should be tested unannounced at least **once** per month for three months- The results of these investigations should be included in the report. Failure to co-operate in the investigations will result in declaring the sample positive.

2. Beta-2 agonists

bambuterol, clenbuterol, fenoterol, formoterol*, reprotol, salbutamol*, salmeterol*, terbutaline^*, ... and related substances-

*Authorized by inhalation as described in Article (LA-).

For salbutamol the definition of a positive under the anabolic agent category is a concentration in urine greater than 1000 nanograms per milliliter.

P. Diuretics

Prohibited substances in class (D) include the following examples:

acetazolamide, bumetanide, chlortalidone, etacrynic acid, furosemide, hydrochlorothiazide, mannitol, mersalyl, spironolactone, triamterene, ... and related substances.

Prohibited by intravenous injection.

E. Peptide hormones, mimetics and analogues

Prohibited substances in class (E) include the following examples and their analogues and mimetics:

1. **Chorionic Gonadotrophin** (hCG) prohibited in males only;
2. **Pituitary and synthetic gonadotrophins** (LH) prohibited in males only;
- 3- **Corticotrophin** (ACTH, tetracosactide);
4. **Growth hormone** (hGH);
5. **Insulin-like Growth Factor (IGF -I);**

and all the respective releasing factors and their analogues;

6. Erythropoietin (EPO);

7. Insulin;

permitted only to treat athletes with certified insulin-dependent diabetes. Written certification of insulin-dependent diabetes must be obtained from an endocrinologist or team physician.

The presence of an abnormal concentration of an endogenous hormone in class (E) or its diagnostic marker(s) in the urine of a competitor constitutes an offence unless it has been proven to be due to a physiological or pathological condition-

II. PROHIBITED METHODS

The following procedures are prohibited:

- 1- Blood doping : means the administration of blood, red blood cells and/or related blood products to an athlete, which may be preceded by withdrawal of blood from the athlete, who continues to train in such a blood-depleted state.
 2- Administering artificial oxygen carriers or plasma expanders;
 3- Pharmacological, chemical and physical manipulation-

III. CLASSES OF PROHIBITED SUBSTANCES IN CERTAIN CIRCUMSTANCES

A. Alcohol

Where the rules of a responsible authority so provide, tests will be conducted for ethanol. **B. Cannabinoids**

Where the rules of a responsible authority so provide, tests will be conducted for cannabinoids (e.g. Marijuana, Hashish). At the Olympic Games, tests will be conducted for cannabinoids. A concentration in urine of 11-nor-delta 9-tetrahydrocannabinol-9-carboxylic acid (carboxy-THC) greater than 15 nanograms per milliliter constitutes doping.

C. Local anaesthetics

Injectable local anaesthetics are permitted under the following conditions:

- a. bupivacaine, lidocaine, mepivacaine, procaine, and related substances, can be used but not cocaine. Vasoconstrictor agents may be used in conjunction with local anaesthetics;
 b. only local or intra-articular injections may be administered;
 c. only when medically justified-
 Where the rules of a responsible authority so provide, notification of administration may be necessary.

D. Glucocorticosteroids

The systemic use of glucocorticosteroids is prohibited when administered orally, rectally or by intravenous or intramuscular injection.

When medically necessary, local and intra-articular injections of glucocorticosteroids are permitted. Where the rules of a responsible medical authority so provide, notification of administration may be necessary.

E. Beta-blockers

Prohibited substances in class (E) include the following examples:

acebutolol, alprenolol, atenolol, labetalol, metoprolol, nadolol, oxprenolol, propranolol, sotalol, ... and related substances.

Where the rules of a responsible authority so provide, tests will be conducted for beta-blockers.

V. OUT-OF-COMPETITION TESTING

Unless specifically requested by the responsible authority, out-of-competition testing is directed solely at prohibited substances in class I.C. (Anabolic Agents), I.D. (Diuretics) I.E. (Peptide Hormones, Mimetics and Analogues), and II (Prohibited Methods).

LIST OF EXAMPLES OF PROHIBITED SUBSTANCES AND PROHIBITED METHODS

CAUTION: This is not an exhaustive list of prohibited substances- Many substances that do not appear on this list are considered prohibited under the term "and related substances". Athletes must ensure that any medicine, supplement, over-the-counter preparation or any other substance they use does not contain any Prohibited Substance.

STIMULANTS:

amineptine, amfepramone, amiphenazole, amphetamine, bambuterol, bromantan, bupropion, caffeine, carphedon, cathine, cocaine, cropropamide, crotethamide, ephedrine, etamivan, etilamphetamine, etilefrine, fencamfamin, fenetylline, fenfluramine, formoterol, heptaminol, mefenorex, mephentermine, mesocarb, methamphetamine, methoxyphenamine, methylenedioxyamphetamine, methylephedrine, niethylphenidate, nikethamide, norfenfluramine, parahydroxyamphetamine, pemoHne, pentetrazol, phendimetrazine, phentermine, phenylephrine, phenylpropanolamine, pholedrine, pipradrol, prolintane, propylhexedrine, pseudoephedrine, reproterol, salbutamol, salmeterol, selegiline, strychnine, terbutaline,

NARCOTICS:

buprenorphine, dextromoramide, diamorphine (heroin), hydrocodone, methadone, morphine, pentazocine, pethidine,

ANABOLIC AGENTS :

androstenediol, androstenedione, bambuterol, boldenone, clenbuterol, clostebol, danazol, dehydrochloromethyltestosterone, dehydroepiandrosterone (DHEA), dihydrotestosterone, drostanolone, fenoterol, fluoxymesterone, formebolone, formoterol, gestrinone, mesterolone, metandienone, metenolone, methandriol, methyltestosterone, mibolerone, nandrolone, 19-norandrostenediol, 19-norandrostenedione, norethandrolone, oxandrolone, oxymesterone, oxymetholone, reproterol, salbutamol, salmeterol, stanozolol, terbutaline, testosterone, trenboione,

DIURETICS :

acetazolamide, bendroflumethiazide, bumetanide, canrenone, chlortalidone, ethacrynic acid, furosemide, hydrochlorothiazide, indapamide, mannito] (by intravenous injection), mersalyl, spironolactone, triamterene,

MASKING AGENTS :

bromantan, diuretics (see above), epitestosterone, probenecid,

PEPTIDE HORMONES, MIMETICS AND ANALOGUES :

ACTH, erythropoietin (EPO), hCG*, hGH, insulin, LH, clomiphene*, cyclofeniJ*, tamoxifen^, aromatase inhibitors*

* prohibited in males only

BETA BLOCKERS :

acebutolol, alprenolol, atenoJol, betaxolol, bisoprolol, bunolol, carteolol, celiprolol, esmoiol, labetalol, levobunoiol, metipranolol, metoprolol, nadolol, oxprenolol, pindolol, propranolol, sotalol, timolol.

Calendar & World Ranking List

At its council meeting in Beijing, FITA Council approved the proposal of the Ad Hoc World Ranking Committee to allow for 6 tournaments per continent effective for the next year. The number of tournaments counting for the ranking remains 3 until further research has been done. A new software system has been developed by FITA in relation with Sportcal to keep information on line for the world ranking, biographies and results. An online results system is available as well and we will offer this service to the organisers of world ranking tournaments.

Also a system will be finalised for the end of the year for a calendar for all FITA recognised tournaments. We will ask certain countries to help us with the test phase and the system will be operational in 2002. The submission of tournaments at that moment for FITA members of Categories 1 and 2 will become mandatory through this system and optional for the smaller nations. We will contact the test countries soon.

FISU Universiads and World University Championships

FISU has announced that archery will be part of the Universiads in 2003. These will be held from 21st August 2003 – 31st August 2003 in Daegu, Korea. We ask you to contact your National University Sports Federation in preparation of these Games to start a preparation. The qualification procedure will be published as soon as possible. However it is very likely that the key qualification tournament will be the World University Championships in Bangkok which will take place from 10th July – 13th July 2002. World Masters Games – Archery 7-11 October 2002

The World Masters Games are going to be held in Melbourne and archery will be a key event in these Games. FITA at its Congress has confirmed the importance of this event and will make it a recognised Championship for Masters. 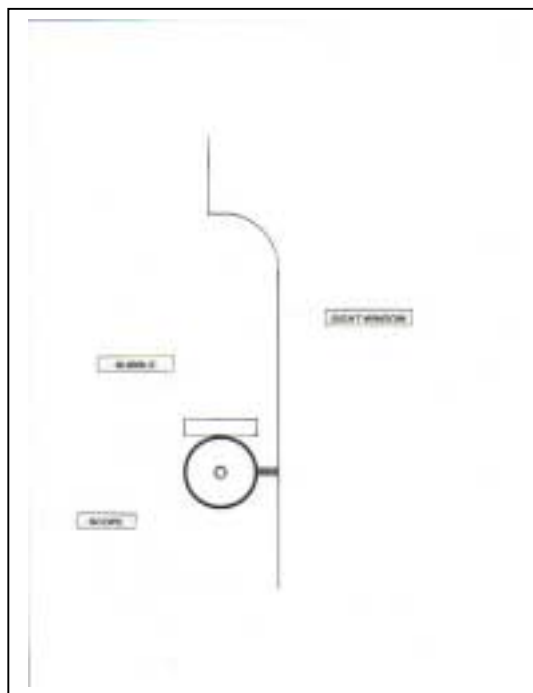
We will publish the entry forms at the start of 2002 in co-operation with the Organising Committees. The deadlines for entries both for preliminary and final entries will be strictly enforced.

World Games Akita

FITA is very proud of the success of the World Games in Akita. The level of competition was very high and the quality of the event was a key to this success. FITA has been helping the participants financially to assist in their travel costs and as such we were able to have the best competitors there. The Field Archery event at the World Games is becoming more and more the Olympic Games for Field Archery and FITA wishes to emphasise this to the Member Associations. Thanks to the help of the IOC, the NOCs will become more and more involved in the future.

Interpretation

Possible Range Finding Device - Submitted by Archery Australia:



Under FITA rules 9.3.4.3 and 9.3.4.4, it is the unanimous decision of the FITA Technical Committee that the sighting device submitted by Archery Australia is not legal under the current rules. The device in question concerns the compound division of FITA and shows an obvious modification to a manufacturer standard issue scope. By removing the level from its original location and placing it on top of the scope, this modification provides two flat planes between the level and the inside of the sight window of the archers bow. The FITA Technical Committee can see no other purpose for this modification other than to create a mechanism useful for the purpose of estimating distances.

Therefore, the device in question is not legal for any FITA Field Competition, but is considered legal for all other disciplines for the FITA Compound division. Note: Although this device would be useful only for the unmarked portion of FITA Field competition, the rules noted above refer to the archer's equipment for all FITA Field events.
