

INTERPRETATIONS

WORLD ARCHERY CONSTITUTION AND RULES

Book 3, Article 11.1.7.1, Book 4, Articles 22.1.7.1, 22.3.7.1, 22.4.6.1, 22.5.6.1

Austria Archery has requested an interpretation as to whether the requirement that all arrow be identical requires that arrows have the same weight. Austria Archery notes that when using arrows with break-off points, it is possible that the points have different weights although appearing to be identical.

The Constitution and Rules Committee (“C&R”) finds the question presented to be within the terms of reference of the Technical Committee after consultation with the Judges Committee.

C&R has determined that the following interpretation is not contrary to the existing rules or Congress decisions.

Response from the Technical Committee:

Where the rules require that all arrows be identical, this means in all respects visually, including length, but does not include weight.
