According to World Archery constitution, changes to competition rules are only allowed in every 4 years, during the Congress following the Olympic Games. Therefore, no motions can be submitted about competition rules for 2019 Congress.

Registration to Congress must be done electronically through WAREOS system

Proxies in case a MA can not participate in Congress, the vote can be delegated with a proxy;

proxy form needs to be filled in and sent to Secretary General

Nominations person in good standing with their MA can be submitted as the candidate;

nominations form has to be filled in and signed by the MA(s) and the candidate
